Newton, MA--On March 20, for the fifth year running, Boston College Law School held its Diversity Bar cocktail event at the School, inviting representatives from state affinity and mainstream bar associations to come, mingle with the students, and discuss life after law school. In attendance were members from the Asian American Lawyers Association of Massachusetts ("AALAM"), Boston Bar Association ("BBA"), Massachusetts Bar Association ("MBA"), Massachusetts Black Lawyers Association ("MBLA") and the Massachusetts Association of Hispanic Attorneys ("MAHA").

At the event, Ingrid C. Schroffner, BC Law Alumni Board Member in charge of affinity groups, and Northeastern University School of Law Prof. Susan Maze-Rothstein, Co-President of the BC Law Alumni Network ("BAN"), said a few words about BC Law's new initiative to build identity-based alumni networks. A handout setting out steps to begin to build those networks was also provided to attendees.

Over 200 students, faculty and alumni packed the Law School Commons at BC Law for the event. Alumni met with the next generation of lawyers at their respective tables that had been set up with information on bar programs and other membership benefits.
