A three-judge panel of the Federal Circuit Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments at Boston College Law School on October 6, 2015, from 2:30-4:30 p.m. in East Wing room 120. Chief Judge Sharon Prost, and Circuit Judges Kimberly Moore and Evan Wallach will take questions from the students in the audience immediately following oral arguments.

The cases to be argued are:

- Enos v. McDonald, Case 15-702 (veteran's claim)
- Integrated Technology Corp. v. Rudolph Technologies, Inc., Case 14-1820 (patent infringement; attorneys' fees)
- Vinyl Visions, LLC v. Oehme (patent infringement)
- Clare v. Chrysler Group LLC (patent infringement)

Prior to the session at 1:15 pm, the School will hold a special Mass in Trinity Chapel.
